along with tickets to sell. This is an excit-



Fieldcrest will be hosting a Literacy Night on May 3rd. More details will be sent home shortly!



# What Are We Learning In April?

## Math: Two-Digit Addition and Subtraction



We will be reviewing some of the skills students have learned about in our previous number sense and numeration units including **representing, comparing and ordering numbers to 100**. We will also be reviewing the addition and subtraction strategies we learned about before the winter break. Students will now be focused on **adding and sub-tracting two-digit numbers** (e.g. 34 + 12) using math materials such as base 10 blocks and hundreds charts, and also using paper and pencil methods.

## **Reading: Making Predictions**

In reading we will be focusing on **making thoughtful predictions** (guesses) as we are reading a text. Students are encouraged to use clues from the pictures, title, author's style, personal experiences and common characteristics of certain kinds of text (for example, fairy tales usually have a happy ending) to help them make their predictions.



# Writing: Point of View and Persuasive Writing



Students are doing a great job writing paragraphs! Our next goal is to work on **persuasive writing.** This is the writing we do when we want to convince someone or persuade them to consider our opinion. We will start by thinking about how people can have different **points of view** on the same topic. For example, in the story <u>The Lorax</u>, the two main characters (the Lorax and the Once-ler) have very different points of view about the use of trees. Students will have a chance to write persuasive letters to their teacher, their principal...and perhaps even their families at home!
